Once at the BEG airport, you may reach Belgrade city center via public transportation. Buses 72 (0,8 EUR) or A1 (5 EUR) are going regularly to Zeleni Venac and to Slavija Square respectively. A1 bus travel time: 20 minutes; 72 bus travel time: 50 minutes.

Taxi from the Airport to the city center should be paid no more than 30 EUR.

**Dr Ivona Lađevac** is a Deputy Director of the Institute of International Politics and Economics and Research Project Manager of the ongoing IIPE project “Serbia and Challenges in International Relations in 2023”, financially supported by the Ministry of Science, Technological Development and Innovation of the Republic of Serbia.
